2023 WILLOWMERE POOL RULES

<u>General</u>

- 1. All Assessments must be paid in full prior to use of the pool.
- 2. Pool passes are required for entry to the pool.
- 3. Hours of operation for all residents are:

May 13 – May 26 Saturday 10-8 Sunday 10-8 Monday - Friday Closed

May 27 – June 9th Saturday 10-8

Sunday 10-8 Monday - Friday 4-8 Memorial Day 10-8

June 10 – August 27

Saturday 10-9 Sunday 10-9 Monday - Friday 10-9

August 28 - September 4

Saturday 10-8 Sunday 10-8 Monday - Friday 4-7 Labor Day 10-8

Sept. 5 – Sept. 10 Saturday 10-8 Sunday 10-8 2 Monday - Friday Closed Anyone entering the pool or pool area outside of the pool hours of operation, or entering the pool without a pool pass or as a guest, is in violation of the Declaration and subject to fines of up to \$100 per violation and suspension of the right to use the pool.

- 4. In the interest of their health, safety and welfare children under 13 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- 5. Private parties must be booked directly through <u>Aquatech website</u> 7 days in advance. Booking the clubhouse does not permit usage of the pool and it must be booked separately.
- 6. The Homeowner's Association will not be responsible for any money or property loss sustained by members or their guests when using the pool.
- 7. Residents and their guests are required to check in when entering the pool and must have a MokoPass account setup.
- 8. The lifeguard will exercise general supervision over the wading pool, but is not responsible for anyone inside the wading pool. Parents or guardians are strongly encouraged to be inside the wading pool enclosure with their children at all times.
- 9. Any person who is incontinent or not fully potty trained must wear appropriate swim diaper or protective clothing when entering the pool.
- 10. Food and beverages may be brought to the pool. All trash must be placed in the trash containers provided. No food and beverages may be consumed while in the pool.
- 11. The following items and activities are prohibited:
 - NO GLASS of any kind is permitted in the pool enclosure.
 - Balls, toys, floats and noodles may be allowed, at the lifeguard on duty's discretion, based on the number of people in the pool.
 - No animals, other than service animals.
 - No smoking, vaping, or other tobacco use within the pool enclosure

- 12. Once every hour the pool may be cleared for a period of ten (10) minutes, or fifteen (15) minutes when only one (1) lifeguard is on duty. During this break, the pool manager and the lifeguards will not be on duty and the facility shall be deemed "swim at your own risk". Safety during these break times shall be the responsibility of the RESIDENT. The pool manager, lifeguards, Aquatech or Willowmere Community Association shall not be responsible for patrons using the pool during said break.
- 13. The pool phone is for pool management use only.

Conduct & Health

- 14. The lifeguards are given full authority to enforce all swimming pool regulations as needed to maintain the safety of members and their guests. Appropriate behavior and cooperation is expected by all residents and their guests.
- 15. Everyone must leave the pool in the event of an emergency (including weather situations such as thunder and lightning storms).
- 16. ANYONE not following rules while at the pool may be asked to leave and can have their swimming privileges removed at the discretion of the Willowmere Community Association Board of Directors.
- 17. Accidents should be reported to the Lifeguard immediately so that a report can be filled out.
- 18. Foul or abusive language, as determined by the Lifeguard, will not be tolerated and will result in disciplinary action.
- 19. You may not take photographs of anyone at the pool without their permission. In the case of minors, parental or guardian permission is required.
- 20. Drug use, fighting, or sexual activity or assault will result in immediate dismissal from the pool area and the proper authorities will be notified. The Lifeguard is authorized to immediately expel violators from the pool area.
- 21. Use of proper bathing suits is required.
- 22. Any person who is incontinent or not fully potty trained must wear appropriate swim diaper or protective clothing when entering the pool.

- 23. Absolutely no diving in the pool or flips from the side are allowed at any time.
- 24. No running, pushing, dunking, rough play or any type of personal conduct endangering safety of self and others is allowed.
- 25. Approved life jackets may be worn in the pool.
- 26. Non-visible consumption of alcoholic beverages is allowed in the pool enclosure.
- 27. Admission to the pool enclosure is forbidden, at the discretion of the pool manager, to anyone wearing bandages, or with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, extremely inflamed eyes, open sores, infections, excessive sunburn, nasal or ear discharge, or other symptoms which are determined by pool management to be detrimental to the health of others.

GUESTS

- 28. Residents may bring up to 4 guests to the pool at a time at no charge.
- 29. If residents wish to bring more than 4 guests they may do so for a charge of \$5 per additional guest and with prior approval by filling out the Pool Guest form on PayHOA at least 48 hours prior to entry.
